Class Codes

Beginner: Little or no experience with fabric selection, rotary cutting equipment, and machine or hand piecing. Beginners should have basic working knowledge of their specific sewing machine for classes requiring a machine.

Intermediate: Previous class and individual experience with rotary cutting equipment and a variety of piecing or appliqué methods suggested. Should have a good understanding of basic quilt construction techniques.

Advanced: For those with substantial class and individual experience with quilt or clothing design and construction techniques.

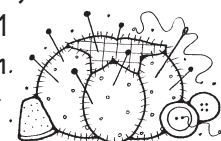

** A RECIPE FOR YOU **

Susy's Famous Carrot Cake

- 4 Eggs
- 2 Cups flour, sifted
- 1 1/2 Cups vegetable oil
- 2 Cups granulated sugar
- 3 Cups packed grated carrots (thank God for food processors!)
- 2 Teaspoons baking soda
- 1 1/2 Teaspoons salt
- 1 Tablespoon Cinnamon

Combine all ingredients, mix until well blended, and bake at 350 degrees for 30 to 35 minutes or until toothpick comes out clean in the center. Allow cake to cool, then frost with the following:

- 1 - 8oz package of cream cheese
- 1 Box of powdered sugar
- 1 Stick of butter
- 1 Teaspoon of vanilla

Combine all ingredients in a food processor until smooth. Frost the cake and you are done!!!

One Note: Some people put chopped walnuts and/or raisins in their cake, but note that if walnuts are added, for some reason when the cake is done they look green (not very attractive) so I don't put them in. Raisins are fine, if you like them.

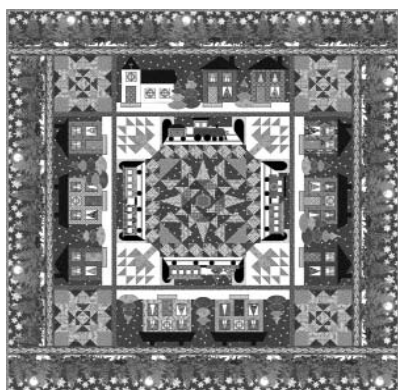
